The University of Central Florida (UCF) is a public research university with its main campus in unincorporated Orange County, Florida. It is part of the State University System of Florida. With 68,442 students as of the Fall 2022 semester, UCF has the second largest on-campus student body of any public university in the United States.

UCF was founded in 1963 and opened its first classes in 1968 as Florida Technological University, with the mission to provide personnel to support the growing U.S. space program at the Kennedy Space Centre and Cape Canaveral Space Force Station on Florida's Space Coast.
