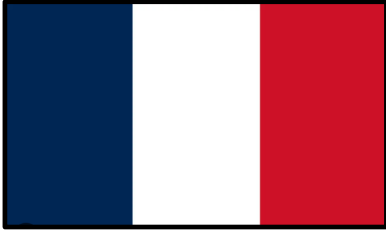


**James Cook University Exchange Partner Factsheet:
