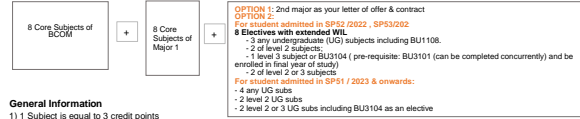

- 3) The subject's level is indicated in the subject code after the prefix, eg: BU1002 = level 1, BX2091 = level 2

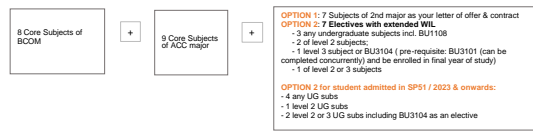
Overlapping subjects for double majors:

For student under **ITD & BKF / BKF & ITD / TD & ECN / ECN & ITD**: There is an overlap of 1 subject. Student will take either BX2053 OR 1 subject from any undergraduate program.
 For student under **TD & FMA / FMA & TD / BKF & ECN / ECN & BKF / FMA & ECN / ECN & FMA**: There are an overlap of 2 subjects. Student will take either:
 (1) BX2053 PLUS 1 subject from any undergraduate program OR (2) 2 subjects from any undergraduate program.

For student under **ACC & FMA / ACC & ECN**: BX3033 under FMA or ECN major is for Non Acc students only. Hence, BX3033 will be removed for students under ACC & FMA or ACC & ECN majors. Student will take the 9 core subjects from ACC major PLUS the remaining 7 subjects from FMA / ECN major.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

- 1) Students must successfully complete 12 credit points at Level 1 before attempting any Level 3 subjects.
- 2) A maximum of 30 credit points may be taken at level 1
- 3) A minimum of 18 credit points must be taken at level 2
- 4) A minimum of 18 credit points must be taken at level 3 & level 4

You must also be in your final trimester and permission to enrol in this subject will only be granted if application is approved by the WIL Coordinator. | | | | | |

* BU1301, BU1302 and BU1303 are Work Integrated Learning (WIL) subjects. To be eligible to apply for a WIL subject, students must successfully complete prescribed online career development modules and quizzes throughout the degree to better prepare them for their WIL experience. Completion of online career development modules and quizzes are compulsory for students admitted in SP53/2018 onward.
